Passwords for STEM Library Resources

STEM Scholars can log into the STEM Library Catalog with their SPS username (without the @seattleschools.org) and their CLEVER password. The K – 2 ipads should have a direct link to Destiny Discover. When prompted select Washington for location and type in Louisa Boren STEM

READING STEM LIBRARY e-BOOKS Online

Once students log into Destiny Discover, they scroll down to the e-books. Some you just click on "OPEN" and others get "checked out"! It depends on the licensing number of copies for each title. Infinity symbol means unlimited access. I would encourage the OPEN before the "Checkout" option as the checkout requires them to then "return" it.
